

ASEAN plus Three Higher Education Dialogue

Beginning in 1997, the ASEAN community began creating organizations within its framework with the intention of achieving their goals. ASEAN Plus Three was the first of these organizations and the network was designed to improve existing ties with the People's Republic of China, Japan, and South Korea. ASEAN Plus Three developed a *Plan of Action on Education: 2010-2017* which emphasizes the need to develop and implement strategies related to quality assurance and the promotion of mobility.

Under the ASEAN+3 Cooperation, the ASEAN University Network is tasked to promote higher education, increase linkages between universities and encourage credit transfers in ASEAN+3 countries. In realization of this vital mission, the "ASEAN +3 Higher Education Policy Dialogue" was successfully convened in Phuket, Thailand in March 2009 with full support by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand, the Office of Higher Education Commission, Thailand and the AUN Secretariat.

As a result, the conference participants agreed to establish an ASEAN+3 University Network and the organisation of ASEAN+3 Rectors' Conference. Subsequent to this agreement, the 1st ASEAN+3 Rectors' Conference was officially inaugurated in November 2012, which marked the official establishment of the ASEAN +3 University Network (ASEAN+3 UNet).
